Strengths (High Rank + High Impact)

1. Teachers as Christian Role Models

- Parents affirm teachers' spiritual example and faith witness.
- National data confirms this is a relative strength.

2. Biblical Worldview Instilled

- Strong performance in integrating faith into academics.
- o Parents recognize the biblical foundation and teaching of core values.

3. Christian Environment

- o The highest-impact driver overall.

Opportunities for Growth (Low Rank + High Impact)

1. Engaging Teaching

- o Very high impact but among the weakest scores nationally (Rank 7).
- o Parents complain about over-reliance on Khan Academy, slideshows, and lack of engaging instruction.

2. Discipline Enforced Consistently

• Very high impact, very low rank (Rank 13).

o Parent comments strongly echo this: inconsistent enforcement, disruptive students not held accountable, and a call for "zero tolerance" on toxic behavior.

3. Parent/Teacher Communication

- o High impact, weak rank (Rank 18).
- o Parents report unanswered emails, inconsistent responsiveness, and unclear expectations.

Summary: The weaknesses align perfectly between data and comments. They center on the student experience in the classroom (engagement, behavior) and the family experience outside the classroom (communication).



Top 5 Concrete Suggestions for Improvement

1. Implement More Hands-On and Project-Based Learning

- Move away from overuse of web-based tools.
- o Use projects, experiments, and exploratory learning to build engagement across all subjects.

2. Provide Professional Development on Student Engagement & Differentiated Instruction

- o Focus on practical strategies for engaging students, classroom management, and lesson planning.
- o Emphasize curiosity, creativity, and critical thinking.

3. Establish and Consistently Enforce Stricter Discipline Protocols

- o Develop a clear schoolwide discipline system with tiered consequences.
- o Prioritize severe issues (bullying, disrespect, fighting) and enforce them fairly and consistently.

4. Offer Training in Classroom Management for Teachers

- o Equip teachers with specific tools to manage disruptive behavior.
- o Provide administrative backup so teachers can stay focused on academics.

5. Enhance Parent-Teacher Communication Consistency

- o Require teachers to respond to parent emails within 24–36 hours.
- o Use a consistent platform (Google Classroom, Schoology, etc.) for posting assignments and updates across all teachers.

Final Takeaway

- **Strengths:** Faith foundation, Christian role modeling, biblical worldview.
- Weaknesses: Engagement in teaching, consistent discipline, and parent communication.
- Why satisfaction is low: The weaknesses are high-impact areas. Until discipline and communication are addressed, satisfaction and referrals will remain in the bottom quintile nationally.
